Evesham Wood was founded in 1986 by Russ Raney with the idea that small is beautiful. To maintain a high level of quality, the winery relies on two basic principles: obtaining optimally ripe, low-yielding fruit from the best possible sites in the Willamette Valley; and using minimal intervention in the winemaking process. That approach is alive and well today under the guidance of Winemaker & Owner Erin Nuccio, and is evident in every bottle produced.

2015 Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley

hand-harvested, hand-sorted, 100% de-stemmed, small lot fermentation, 10 months in neutral barrel

2014 Pinot Noir Illahe Vineyard, Willamette Valley

a warm site that experiences slightly earlier bud break than most in the Willamette Valley, farmed organically, 275 cases produced

2014 Pinot Noir Temperance Hill Vineyard, Eola-Amity Hills

certified organic vineyard with an elevation of 660 to 860 feet making it a cool site. Mostly Nekia, Rittner & Jory soils, 145 cases produced

2014 Pinot Noir Le Puits Sec, Eola-Amity Hills

the estate vineyard (pictured below), tightly spaced, gentle sloping, east-facing vineyard with volcanic basalt soils, 525 cases produced

2014 Pinot Noir Cuvee J, Eola-Amity Hills

selection of six premium barrels from Le Puits Sec, 149 cases produced
